Subject: Ministry Decree 28 June 2011 – art.4 clause 1 – Catalogue of road restraint systems.

According to art. 4, clause 1 of the Ministry Decree 28.6.2011, the Catalogue of road restraint systems is being established by the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructures and will be posted in the [www.mit.gov.it](http://www.mit.gov.it) web site.

The information defined in clause 2 of the Ministry Decree are collected in the on-line Catalogue that will be accessible by road authorities, designers and producers.

When a device is introduced in the Italian market for the first time, the producers (or their delegate to produce) shall send to the General Directorate for Road Safety of the Ministry the information concerning the device compiling and sending the attached form and all the required files.

The information collected in the Catalogue can be used by the producers for the participation to bids and by the Road Administrations to check the documentation pertaining a given device listed in the Catalogue.

In order to allow a first implementation of the Catalogue this Directorate is gathering information pertaining the devices already in the Italian market.

The first data gathering phase will be concluded by June 30, 2016 and will include all the devices for which the full documentation required in the attached form has been submitted to [catalogobarriere.dgss@mit.gov.it](mailto:catalogobarriere.dgss@mit.gov.it) by April 30, 2016.

After the first activation, the catalogue will be updated every 2 months based on the information that will be sent by the producers.
